## PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Qui Vive Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members and the game of cricket in general. The club believes that it is important that members should at all times show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the QCC Board.

As a player for Qui Vive Cricket Club, you are expected to abide by the following rules:

- All players must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All players must respect opponents.
- Players should keep to agreed timings for matches and practice or inform their captain if they are going to be late.
- Players must wear suitable kit for matches and practice sessions.
- Players must pay any fees for matches or practice on the day.
- Foul and/or abusive language on or off the field is unacceptable.
- Intimidation, aggressive behavior and/or deliberate distraction of opponents by words or actions are unacceptable.
- Players are not allowed to smoke or consume alcohol on the pitch at any time
- Players are not allowed to take drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- It is expected that teams will do their utmost to win but the highest standards of sportsmanship in keeping with the spirit of the game should be displayed.
- The captains are responsible at all times for ensuring that play is conducted within the Spirit of Cricket as well as within the laws.
- Players must at all times accept the Umpire's decision. Players must not show dissent at the umpire's decision or react in a provocative or disapproving manner towards the umpire at any time.
- Players shall not at any time intimidate, assault or attempt to intimidate or assault an umpire, another player, or a spectator.
- Players shall not make racial or sectarian comments or indulge in racial or sectarian actions against fellow players, officials, members or supporters. Qui Vive Cricket Club operates an 'open door' membership policy welcoming membership from all sections of the community.
- Players in teams below the first eleven must take their turn in umpiring, scoring or performing other tasks as instructed by the captain.
- All players must accept the decisions made by the captain on the pitch without question.
- All players are required to help out in arranging lunch and help the person behind the bar in arranging the tables and cleaning up.
- All players have to ensure that all the dressing rooms are cleaned at the end of the day.
- All players should ensure that all materials are returned back to the storage room.
